





# Red Cliff

---

- Decade has earned 60% interest in the property from Mountain Boy Minerals Ltd.
- The property consists of 8 crown granted claims along Lydden Creek, just north of Stewart, B.C.
- Road accessible 1.5km from paved highway
- 2 main mineralized zones – Red Cliff Copper-Gold and Copper Zones & Montrose Gold Zone
- Mineralization has been outlined over 1.5 kilometers of strike and is open along strike and at depth.

  - 4.75 g/t gold over 39.63 meters in DDH-2009-MON-5
  - 20.87 g/t gold over 24.7 meters in DDH-2009-MON-6




# Premier East

---

- 100% interest in 1937.34 hectares within 10 mineral claims along the east edge of the former Premier Silbak mine area.
- The northern portion of the property is near the Premier Silbak mine which is located 2 kilometers west of the claim boundary.
- Significant showing are present on the newly acquired claims including the Premier East as well as the historic Bayview and Franklin mineral occurrences. The Premier East mineralization consists of a galena, sphalerite, pyrite and tetrahedrite stockwork up to 5 metres wide along a sericite altered zone on strike with the Premier mine mineralization.



- The companies, Mountain Boy Minerals and Decade Resources, acquired a total of 37,296.28 ha in 80 claims.



# Blackwater Area Claims

---

- Richfield has recently announced exceptional drill results from its Blackwater Gold Project, including 205m of 2.04 g/t Au (Reported in Stockwatch, January 25, 2011), and 145 metres of 2.70 g/t Au. (Reported in Stockwatch, March 15, 2011).
- At a base case cut-off grade of 0.40 g/t Au, the estimated global indicated resource is 53.46 million tonnes at an average grade of 1.06 g/t Au containing 1.83 million ounces gold, with an additional 75.45 million tonnes at an average grade of 0.96 g/t Au containing 2.34 million ounces gold in the inferred category.



# Stamp

- The Stamp Claims are located just south of the BA Project, a joint venture between Mountain Boy Minerals Ltd. and Great Bear Resources Ltd. The claims are subject to a joint venture agreement between Teuton Resources and Decade.
- Drilling to date on the adjoining property has tested the same stratigraphic horizon that hosted the Eskay Creek deposit; which historically produced more than 100 tonnes of gold and 5000 tonnes of silver from start-up in 1995, until closure in 2008.
- Work in 2010 has indicated anomalous zinc and silver values in mudstones.
- Airborne survey in 2010 has indicated a VTEM anomaly on the claims.


# Goat

---

- 3 claims, located over the former Goat Mine (a small producer in the 1970's), in the Surprise Creek Valley approximately 34 kilometers northeast of Stewart, B.C. and 5 kilometers north of the Stewart Highway (37A).
- The property is underlain by narrow polymetallic gold and silver veins as well as the same stratigraphic horizon that hosts the BA Kuroko type silver-lead-zinc mineralization approximately 8 kilometers to the south.
- This is within the same stratigraphic horizon that hosted the Eskay Creek deposit, which produced more than 100 tonnes of gold and 5,000 tonnes of silver from start-up in 1995, until closure in 2008.

# Goat

- Proven and probable reserves in 1979 were 8800 tonnes grading 4782.9 grams per tonne silver and 10.6 grams per tonne gold.
- Upper Workings at the Goat Mine.
