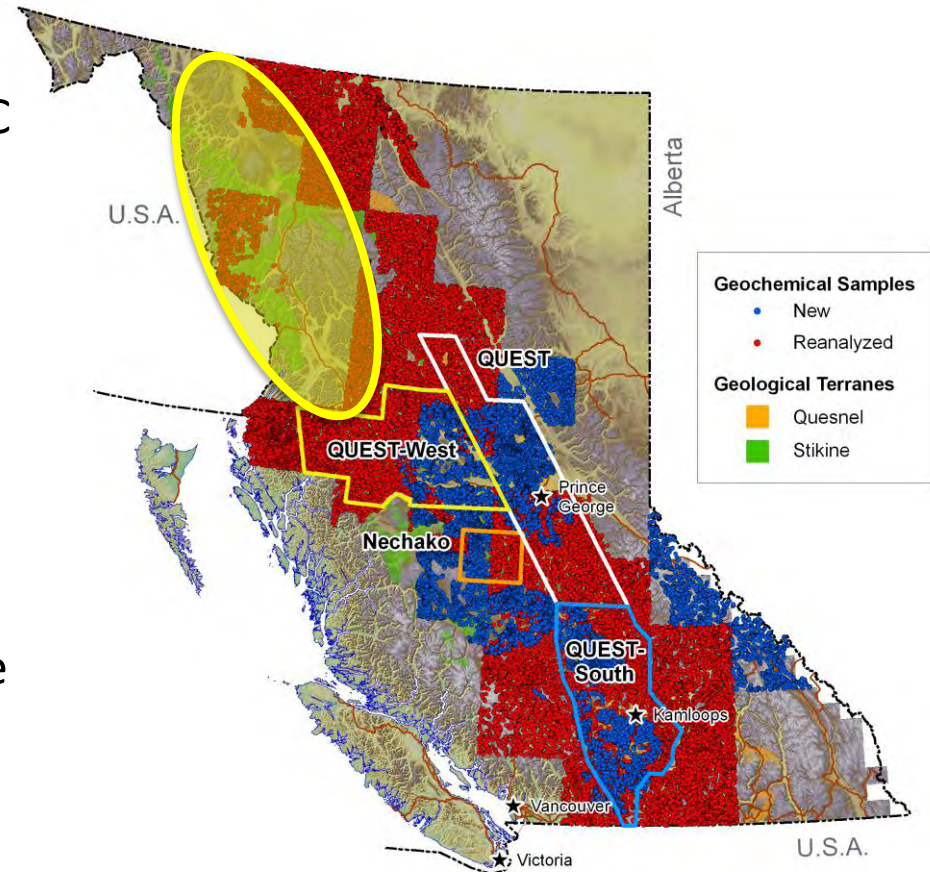

- GBC Board recently approved a budget of \$ 3 million for QUEST-Northwest
- Huge support from communities and local government for work in the northwest
- Opportunity to help maximize the return on investment for the development of the northwest transmission line

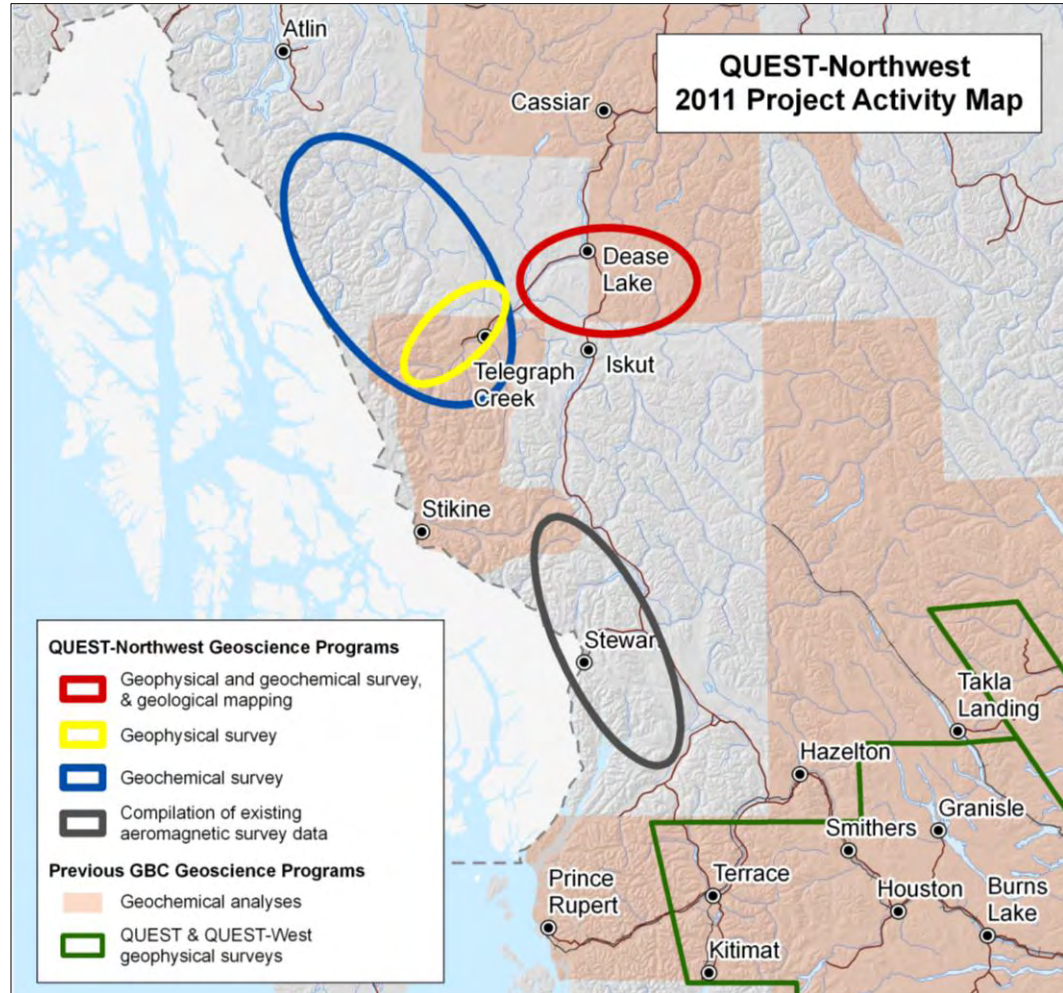




# QUEST-Northwest – Planned Activities



- High resolution airborne magnetic surveys in the Dease Lake/Iskut and Telegraph Creek area s
- New regional geochemical surveys in the Dease Lake/Iskut area
- Reanalysis of archived geochem samples from northwest of Telegraph Creek and new sampling in Dease Lake area
- Partnership bedrock mapping project with the BC Geological Survey around Dease Lake
- Compilation of existing aeromagnetic data in the area around Stewart
- First Nations involvement through community engagement and workshops led by Kirby Muldoe from Hazelton
- NWCC School of Exploration and Mining First Nation student work experience
