 All project interim and final payment submissions are analyzed and issued to the community or business client within 10 working days




### **Results-Driven Efficiency**

- Operates at a very low overhead of 0.5% of capital base
- Since inception, over \$47 Million has been committed into 317 regional economic development projects worth over \$306 Million in capital investment into the region
- Over 1,200 new jobs created in the first 3 years of funding community and business initiatives
- Attracted over \$8 Million in corporate commitments as a result of its highly efficient and effective programming
- Attracted \$5 into projects from other sources for every \$1 invested by Northern Development

### **Exponential Growth in Program Demand**




### **Direct Job Creation From Investments**

### **Strong First Nations Leadership**

Northern Development has invested \$6.3 Million and over 15% of its funding into 27 economic development projects directly led by First Nations. The organization also connects business directly with First Nations and incorporated communities, and partners with First Nations focused foundations to improve the economy in these culturally rich but economically vulnerable communities.



### **Unique Job Creation Business Incentives**

Northern Development launched the *Northern BC Business Advantage* in 2008 to support businesses expanding and creating new jobs in the manufacturing sector. The Capital Investment and Training *Rebate* has resulted in the commitment of over 400 new jobs and \$25 Million in capital investment by business in less than 6 months.

# Capital Investment and Training Rebate

- \$10,000 per eligible job created
- Maximum \$2.5 million per company
- Streamlined approval process currently less than one week for complete applications
- 10 Manufacturing companies approved with over 400 new jobs and \$27 being invested in our regional economy
- Many other companies developing expansion business plans and applications to this program

### **Competitiveness Consulting Rebate**

- Funds 50% of business consulting costs to province better access to expertise for rural BC small and medium sized businesses
- Helps manufactures, processors, and their suppliers grow their businesses, implement world-class business practices and be more competitive in the global market
- Consultants are contracted by business and the Business Development Bank of Canada (BDC) Consulting Division - Northern Development sends rebate after contract completed to satisfaction of business








